


NGO

② Issues because of NGO

- Accountability & credibility : questioned due to lack of transparency in budget keeping.
- legitimacy challenge : accused of whitening black money. ④
- Islamic research foundation accused of round tripping.
- non compliance : more than 80% NGOs don't submit their balance sheet.

③ Issues within NGO

- management issues
- Silos mentality - work on narrow interest
- fragmentation : even NGOs with similar function lack integration
